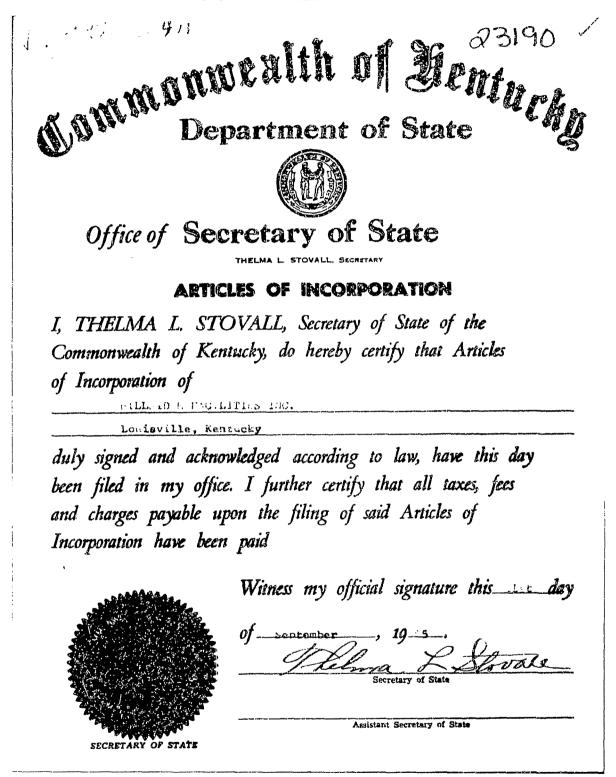

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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF HILLRIDGE FACILITIES INC.

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KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: THAT WE, the undersigned, Don Ridge, Joyce Ridge, Donald Ridge, Jr., and Cecilia Ridge, have associated ourselves together to form and do hereby form a corporation under the laws of the Commonwealth of kentucky and do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation is:

"HILLRIDGE FACILITIES INC."

ARTICLE 11.

The objects and purposes for which this corporation is organized, and the business to be promoted, transacted and carried on, and which said corporation is vested with authority to promote, transact and carry on, is as follows:

a. To accept, acquire, purchase, own, hold, service, repair, reconstruct, manage, operate and maintain the sewerage system, including the sewerage collection system and appurtenances, together with a sewerage treatment plant, in Jefferson County, Kentucky in what is known as <u>Hillridge</u> <u>Subdivision</u> for the purpose of supplying sewerage disposal service to all properties connected or to be connected to said sewerage system, that lie in said <u>Hillridge Subdivision</u>, or near or adjacent thereto, to the reasonable capacity of said system;

b. To acquire, own, hold, and use real estate, appurtenances and easements in said subdivision and adjacent thereto, to the extent that it may be reasonably necessary to the transaction of its said business;

c. To acquire, own, hold, and use sewer lines equipment and disposal and treatment units;

d. To obligate itself to furnish continuous sewerage collection and treatment services to parties owning property at any time connected to said system, pursuant to contract with such parties inuring to the benefit of such parties and their successors in title, at uniform rates and formulas for fixing rates to be set out in such contracts, with provisions for the transfer of said system to any body, division, or sanitation district at any time serving said area, who will take over said system or furnish a new system;

e. To secure the performance of its oblgations in any manner it may elect;

f. To contract with others to do or perform any and all things that it is authorized to do for itself;

g. To borrow money and secure the same by mortgage or pledge of its property and assets;

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h. To sell, convey, transfer, deed in trust and lease real estate and personal property;

i. To do all things necessary or proper or convenient in and in connection therewith that may now or hereafter be permitted by law, the same as a natural person might or could do, and the foregoing enumerations shall not be construed in limitation of the business and powers of this corporation.

ARTICLE 111.

This corporation shall begin its corporate existence as soon as these Articles are approved by the Secretary of State of Kentucky and its existence shall be perpetual until dissolved in accordance with law.

ARTICLE IV.

The address of the Registered Office of this corporation in Kentucky is 2143 Buechel Bank Road, Louisville, Jefferson County,Kentucky, and the name and address of the Registered Agent of this Corporation is: Don Ridge, 2143 Buechel Bank Road, Louisville, Jefferson County,Kentucky.

ARTICLE V.

The total number of authorized par value shares of authorized Capital Stock of this corporation is 1,000 shares and the par value of each share is \$50.00 making a total authorized Capital Stock of \$50,000,00. The voting rights of stockholders shall be one vote for each share of common stock.

ARTICLE VI.

All of the stock of this corporation shall be common stock.

ARTICLE VII.

The corporation shall begin business when \$1,000.00 of the capital has been paid in to this corporation.

ARTICLE VIII.

The names of the incorporators and the number of shares of stock subscribed for by each are as follows:

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ARTICLE IX.

The affairs of this corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors. The first Board of Directors shall be elected by the stockholders upon the approval and recording of these Articles, and shall hold office until the first annual meeting of stockholders. Thereafter all Directors shall be elected for a term of one year at the regular annual meeting of the stockholders to be held at the office of the Company in Louisville,Kentucky on the <u>2nd</u> in <u>January</u> of each year. Three directors shall be elected at the first meeting, of the stockholders.

Each Board of Directors upon being elected shall elect a Fresident, tho shall be a member of the Board, and shall also elect a Vice-President, Treasurer and Secretary, and such other officers as the business of the Company may require, which Vice-President Secretary and other officers need not be members of the Board of Directors. Any two officers except the President, may be held by the same person. All directors and officers shall hold office until their successors are elected and qualified. The Board of Directors may adopt by-laws subject to the right of the stockholders to amend and change the by-laws, but such bylaws until so amended or changed and up to the date of the amendment or change shall be valid. All officers and Directors shall hold office at the pleasure of the stockholders.

ARTICLE X.

The highest amount of indebtedness which this corporation may at any time incur and have outstanding is \$5000,000.00.

ARTICLE XI.

The private property of the stockholders shall be not liable for the payment of the debts or obligations of this corporation.
