ORDER

U.S. 60 Water District has requested a deviation from 807 KAR 5:001, Section 11(2)(a), which requires the filing of a financial exhibit covering “operations for a twelve (12) month period . . . ending not more than ninety (90) days prior to the date the application is filed.”¹ It has provided its financial statements for calendar year 2011 and represents that there has been no change that is material in nature in its financial condition or operation since the publication of these statements.

Finding that U.S. 60 Water District has demonstrated good cause to permit its deviation from 807 KAR 5:001, Section 11(2)(a), the Commission HEREBY ORDERS that:

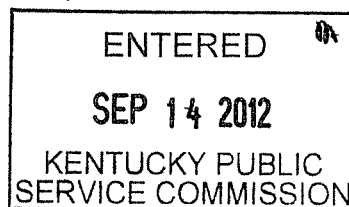
1. U.S. 60 Water District’s motion to deviate from 807 KAR 5:001, Section 11(2)(a), is granted.

¹ 807 KAR 5.001, Section 6. 807 KAR 5.001, Section 11(2)(a), refers to Section 6. While U.S. 60 Water District requests a deviation from 807 KAR 5.001, Section 6, its requested relief requires a deviation from 807 KAR 5.001, Section 11(2)(a). The Commission will consider U.S. 60 Water District’s request as a motion to deviate from 807 KAR 5.001, Section 11(2)(a).

2. U.S. 60 Water District's application is considered filed as of the date of this Order.

3. Nothing contained in this Order shall preclude the Commission from requiring the production of information regarding U.S. 60 Water District's financial condition or operations since December 31, 2011.
