Some years ago when LG&E requested that the No. 2 Unit at the Trimble County power plant be calculated in the rate base, the PSC, based on the determination that LG&E had excess generating capacity, forced LG&E to sell the No. 2 Unit. If Kenergy has excess generating capacity, I think that if they don't want to sell the excess power on the GRID, then they should be forced to sell their excess unit(s) to someone who will sell the power on the GRID. Kenergy has a choice, but apparently they don't want to exercise it.
