On October 3, 2013, Commission Staff, representatives from Kentucky Cable Telecommunications Association ("KCTA"), and representatives from Hickman-Fulton Counties Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation, Pennyrile Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation, Tri-County Electric Membership Corporation, Warren Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation, and West Kentucky Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation (collectively "TVA Cooperatives") participated in a telephonic informal conference. A copy of the sign-in sheet of those who participated is attached.

The purpose of the informal conference was to discuss the future procedure to follow after the Commission's granting of rehearing. Commission Staff noted that the issues presented in the case were mixed questions of fact and law. Commission Staff also noted that there was no evidence in the record to support the argument for Commission preemption over the pole attachment rates of the TVA Cooperatives. Commission Staff suggested that discovery might be necessary, with the opportunity to go forward to a hearing, if necessary. Commission Staff suggested that the parties agree on a discovery schedule. The parties conferred on potential deadlines for the discovery schedule and reached a tentative agreement in a schedule which they would file with the Commission shortly.

Thereafter the conference concluded.
