ORDER

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:056, the Commission, on February 11, 2013, established this case to review and evaluate the application of the Fuel Adjustment Clause ("FAC") of Meade County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Meade") for the two-year period from November 1, 2010 through October 31, 2012.

As part of this review, the Commission ordered Meade to submit certain information and an affidavit attesting to its adherence to 807 KAR 5:056. The Commission further ordered that a public hearing be held in this case but cancelled it when, after publication of notice, no interested person advised the Commission of his or her intent to attend.

The Commission, having considered the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that:

1. During the period under review, Meade has complied in all material respects with the provisions of 807 KAR 5:056.

2. As Big Rivers Electric Corporation, the wholesale supplier of Meade, has been authorized to maintain its base fuel rate at its current level,¹ Meade's proposal to maintain its rates at their current level should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The charges and credits applied by Meade through the FAC for the period from November 1, 2010 through October 31, 2012 are approved.
 - 2. Meade's proposal to maintain its rates at their current level is approved.
