COMMISSION STAFF'S THIRD REQUEST FOR INFORMATION  
TO EAST KENTUCKY POWER COOPERATIVE, INC.

East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. ("EKPC"), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, is to file with the Commission the original and ten copies of the following information, with a copy to all parties of record. The information requested herein is due within 14 days of the date of this request. Responses to requests for information shall be appropriately bound, tabbed and indexed. Each response shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to questions related to the information provided.


Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or the person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

EKPC shall make timely amendment to any prior response if it obtains information which indicates that the response was incorrect when made or, though correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect. For any request to which EKPC fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, it shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention shall be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When applicable, the requested information shall be separately provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations.

1. Refer to the original and updated "Proposal Evaluation\_Energy Production" spreadsheet filed under seal in response to Item 5 of Commission Staff's Initial Information Request ("Staff's First Request") and Item 18.e. of the Sierra Club's Supplemental Request for Information, respectively. The amount in cell R85 on the "Summary" tab in both the original and updated spreadsheets is the same amount. Refer also to cell S38 on the "Summary\_Intermittent" tab in the "Proposal Evaluation\_Energy Calculated" spreadsheet filed under seal in response to Item 5 of Staff's First Request.

- a. Explain why the amounts in cell R85 and S38 differ when both cells are referencing the net present value per MW year for the same proposal.
- b. State which amount is the correct net present value per MW year.
