## Re: 2013-000148 - Atmos Confidential Materials

Dear Mr. Derouen:

This letter will confirm receipt of your January 30<sup>th</sup> letter to me as well as my telephone conversation of this morning with Virginia Gregg. Stand Energy did not sign a confidentiality agreement in this case. Stand Energy removed ourselves from the room during the Atmos hearing discussion of confidential materials. Nevertheless, we understand that confidential materials may have been mailed to Stand Energy inadvertently by the PSC.

Upon being contacted by Ms. Gregg, I agreed to return any confidential materials received by Stand Energy UNOPENED. I appreciate the situation and I understand Stand Energy should not view confidential materials. Unfortunately, Ms. Gregg described the confidential materials as being contained in a manila envelope which has not been received.

I have received two pieces of mail from the PSC since the hearing. Both regular white envelopes. One was postmarked January 30<sup>th</sup> and was addressed with an address label affixed to the envelope. The second letter was postmarked January 31<sup>st</sup> and was addressed by either a printer or a typewriter. The January 31<sup>st</sup> envelope was opened this morning at the direction of Ms. Gregg and contained Mr. Derouen's letter on this subject. The first letter we received postmarked January 30<sup>th</sup> is enclosed UNOPENED for your review. We will continue to watch for any manila folder from the PSC.
