I have been a widow for 36 years. A few years ago I sold a farm that we bought together. This year unknown to me the bank gave me .25 for the money, I am not getting \$36⁰⁰ a month.

In 1993 I bought a double-wide all electric home. Shortly thereafter the doctor I had stopped my driving. I think of Senior Citizens stopped my going to the Senior Center were I had been going for years. As my brother died from alzheimers doctor

had wrote a letter saying I needed to get
out in public read, and work ^{power} which
I set there doing not bothering anyone.

To get back to the electric during
the month of November I used more than
2,000 kilowatts. When we took the outside
they told it would never go over \$6.95
I am now paying ^{as high as} \$10.80 to keep them
away from my old home

Being disabled I am on eight
prescriptions which do not come cheap. Some
of them or not generic. I am on my
husband's social security which is
not the price most everyone is getting.
P.S.C I just wish that would stop
Big Rivers from putting so much
on poor disabled people.
