

I wish to express my opposition to the announced intentions of AmeriGas to discontinue our current gas service and replace it with individual residential tanks. The following points should be considered.

- Our system is less than 6 years old and is performing well.
- To my knowledge there have been no complaints regarding our present system.
- Common sense shows the proposed changes will not increase efficiency and will not be esthetically pleasing.
- We have all paid significant tap on fees (\$500-1000) to receive the current gas supply.
- The neighborhood should not be penalized with increasing gas prices for the benefit of the parent company.
- We would expect that an environmental study would be needed before any metal tanks containing gas could be buried.
- Current deed restrictions do not allow burial of gas tanks on our properties.
