

It has come to our attention that the gas provider for Old Bridge, AmeriGas, has requested to change the current pipeline delivery system to individual residential tanks. Please consider this letter an official protest to this request because of the following reasons:

- The deed restrictions for Old Bridge prohibit tanks, either above or below ground.
- Residents have already paid significant connection fees ranging from \$600.00 to \$1000.00 in order to access the gas pipeline.
- Our yard, as well as those of other residents, is full of overflow lines and an elaborate septic system, and there is not enough room for a tank.
- Such an arrangement would create an environmental issue and would be unsafe.
- This plan would not increase efficiency and would not be esthetically pleasing to our neighborhood.
- This plan would have a negative impact on home values and home sales.

We appreciate your careful consideration of this matter and hope your conclusion will be to reject the AmeriGas plan.
