Notice Of Requested Date For Decision


In response to the request from Staff, Kentucky Power notifies the Public Service Commission of Kentucky that it requires a decision on or before June 30, 2014 with respect to its pending application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity in this case.

The decision is required to permit the contractor that will provide natural gas service to Big Sandy Unit 1 to begin the necessary work for the acquisition of rights-of-way and construction of the required natural gas pipeline in time to bring the facility on line by mid-May 2016.¹

This 29th day of April, 2014.

¹ Any extension for the operation of Big Sandy Unit 1 as a coal-fired facility under the Mercury And Air Toxics Standards rule would expire April 16, 2016.

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
