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ORDER

On August 22, 2014, Louisville Gas and Electric Company and Kentucky Utilities Company (collectively "Joint Applicants") submitted a formal notice of their withdrawal of that part of their April 21, 2014 Joint Application requesting a site compatibility certificate for the construction of a 700-megawatt ("MW") natural gas combined-cycle combustion ("NGCC") turbine unit at the Green River Generating Station. Joint Applicants also indicated that their withdrawal of the request for a site compatibility certificate for the Green River NGCC does not impact a similar request for the construction of a 10-MW solar photovoltaic facility at the E.W. Brown Generating Station. Joint Applicants further requested that the Joint Application, as amended by this notice, be resumed and a procedural schedule be established that is consistent with the procedural schedule to be issued in the related Case No. 2014-00002.¹


Having reviewed the notice and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that Joint Applicants have established good cause to permit them to withdraw their request for a site compatibility certificate to construct the Green River NGCC. The Commission further finds that the instant matter should be taken out of abeyance and resumed pursuant to the procedural schedule attached as an appendix to this Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Joint Applicants' notice of withdrawal is granted and the April 21, 2014 Joint Application shall be treated as amended to remove the site compatibility certificate request for the Green River NGCC.

2. The processing of this matter is resumed and the procedural schedule set forth in the appendix, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, to this Order shall be followed.
