ORDER

On May 1, 2014, Northern Kentucky Water District (“NKWD”) submitted its application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity (“CPCN”) and approval of financing. NKWD included a supporting document with its CPCN application that revealed its federal tax identification number as well as a loan number. Federal employer identification and loan numbers are considered confidential and exempted from disclosure under the Kentucky Open Records Act.¹ On May 8, 2014, NKWD electronically submitted a complete revised filing with the confidential information redacted.

Accordingly, the Commission, on its own motion, HEREBY Orders that:

1. The federal identification number and loan identification number contained with NKWD’s original application meet the criteria for confidential treatment and are exempted from public disclosure pursuant to KRS 61.878(1) and 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13.

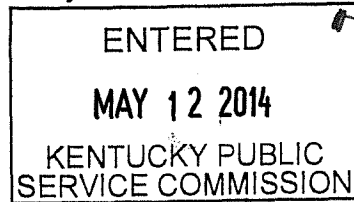

2. The federal identification number and loan identification number should not be placed in the public record or made available for public inspection for an indefinite period of time.

3. The documents that revealed the federal identification and loan identification numbers shall be placed in a confidential file.

4. Use of the materials in question in any Commission proceeding shall comply with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13(9).
