

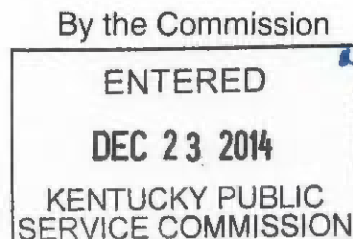
ORDER

On November 14, 2014, Joe F.
