ORDER

On July 31, 2014, Kentucky-American Water Company (“Kentucky-American”) tendered an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 22, Kentucky-American requested a deviation from the requirement¹ that it provide a copy of the building permit from Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government (“LFUCG”); the land disturbance permit from LFUCG; the Kentucky Division of Water’s (“DOW”) approval of Kentucky-American’s notice of intent to disturb land; and the demolition/wrecking permit from LFUCG.

In support of its request for a deviation, Kentucky-American indicates that it intends to apply for the LFUCG building permit later this year.² In 2015, Kentucky-American intends to apply for the LFUCG land disturbance permit and issue a notice of intent to disturb the land to the DOW.³ Kentucky-American intends to apply for the LFUCG demolition/wrecking permit in 2016.⁴

Having considered the motion, the Commission finds that:

1. The omission from Kentucky-American's application of a copy of the LFUCG building permit; the LFUCG land disturbance permit; the DOW approval of Kentucky-American's notice of intent to disturb land; and the LFUCG demolition/wrecking permit will not impede the Commission's investigation and review of Kentucky-American's application. For this reason, Kentucky-American's request for a deviation from the requirement to provide copies of those permits at this time is reasonable and the requested deviation should be granted.

2. Kentucky-American should provide a copy of the LFUCG building permit; the LFUCG land disturbance permit; the DOW approval of Kentucky-American's notice of intent to disturb land; and the LFUCG demolition/wrecking permit within ten days of obtaining each permit or approval.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Kentucky-American's request for a deviation from the requirement that it provide at this time a copy of the LFUCG building permit; the LFUCG land disturbance permit; the DOW approval of Kentucky-American's notice of intent to disturb land; and the LFUCG demolition/wrecking permit is granted.


2. Kentucky-American shall provide a copy of the LFUCG building permit; the LFUCG land disturbance permit; the DOW approval of Kentucky-American's notice of intent to disturb land; and the LFUCG demolition/wrecking permit within ten days of obtaining each permit or approval.

3. The permits and approval required to be filed pursuant to ordering paragraph 2 shall be filed in the record of this case if it is still open; otherwise the

permits and approval shall be filed with this case number and shall be maintained in the utility's general correspondence file.

4. Kentucky-American's application is considered filed as of the date of this Order.
