ORDER

On July 31, 2014, Kentucky-American Water Company ("KAWC") tendered an application seeking authority for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct a filter building, eight filters, a chlorine contact basin, and a backwash tank at KAWC's Richmond Road Station to replace the existing filter building. The application was accepted for filing by the Commission in its August 25, 2014 Order granting KAWC's motion for a deviation.

Having reviewed the application, the Commission finds that an investigation will be necessary to determine the reasonableness of the proposed construction.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- The procedural schedule set forth in the Appendix attached to this Order shall be followed.
- 2. a. Responses to requests for information shall be appropriately bound, tabbed and indexed and shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to questions related to the information provided, with an electronic copy to all parties of record and an original and electronic copy to the Commission.

b. Each response shall be answered under oath, or for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or an association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

c. A party shall make timely amendment to any prior response if it obtains information which indicates that the response was incorrect when made or, though correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect.

d. For any request to which a party fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, that party shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

3. A person who submits a motion to intervene after October 7, 2014, and, upon a showing of good cause, is granted leave to intervene shall accept and abide by the existing procedural schedule.

4. Motions for extensions of time with respect to the schedule herein shall be made in writing and will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

5. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering further Orders in this matter.
