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#### ORDER

On November 12, 2014, Duke Energy Kentucky, Inc. ("Duke Kentucky") electronically filed its annual Demand-Side Management ("DSM") status report. In addition to the status report, Duke Kentucky filed its proposed DSM tariff Rider DSMR (Demand Side Management Rate) reflecting revisions to the DSM rates to be effective on December 15, 2014. By Order entered December 3, 2014, the Commission suspended the proposed rates through May 14, 2015. The Commission finds that a procedural schedule should be established to facilitate the processing of this matter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The procedural schedule set forth in the Appendix to this Order shall be followed.

2. a. Responses to requests for information shall be filed in accordance with the electronic filing procedures set forth in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8, and shall be appropriately indexed, bookmarked, and searchable and shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided, with copies to all parties of record and an original paper copy to the Commission.

b. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or an association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

c. A party shall make timely amendment to any prior response if it obtains information which indicates that the response was incorrect when made or, though correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect.

d. For any request to which a party fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, that party shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

3. A person who submits a motion to intervene after December 31, 2014 and, upon a showing of good cause, is granted full intervention shall accept and abide by the existing procedural schedule.

4. Any party filing testimony shall file in accordance with the electronic filing procedures set forth in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8, with an original paper copy to the Commission.

5. Duke Kentucky shall publish notice of any hearing in this matter in accordance with the provisions set out in KRS 424.300 and 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(2).

6. At any public hearing in this matter, neither opening statements nor summarization of direct testimonies shall be permitted.

7. Any objections or motions relating to discovery or procedural dates shall be filed upon four business days' notice or the filing party shall explain, in writing, why such notice was not possible.

8. Motions for extensions of time with respect to the schedule herein shall be made in writing and will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

9. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering further Orders in this matter.
