RE: Informal Conference of November 14, 2014

Pursuant to a Staff Notice issued on October 22, 2014, an informal conference ("IC") was conducted at the Commission's offices in Frankfort, Kentucky on November 14, 2014. In attendance were members of the Commission Staff ("Staff"), representatives of Shelby Energy Cooperative, Inc. ("Shelby Energy") and representatives of Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU"). Attached is a copy of the attendance roster ("Attachment A").

The purpose of the IC was to resolve differences between the certified territory boundary lines on file with the Commission and the purported current service territory boundary lines as depicted on Exhibit 2 to the application filed in Case No. 2014-00223 and on Exhibits 2 and 4 to the application filed in Case No. 2014-00224, and to determine the proposed certified service territory boundary lines.

Prior to the IC, Shelby Energy provided the attached documents that evidence prior agreements between Shelby Energy and Kentucky Utilities Company (attached as "Attachment B"). Staff and Shelby Energy discussed the documents and agreed that the documents resolved differences in boundary lines in the Glenview section of the Shelbyville quadrangle map.

Representatives of Shelby Energy and KU agreed upon boundary lines for the Old Mill Village section on the Shelbyville quadrangle map, the southern Meadow Glen section on the Shelbyville quadrangle map, and the Rolling Ridge section on the Simpsonville quadrangle map. Shelby Energy representatives indicated that field work will be required to physically review existing services in the northern Meadow Glen section on the Shelbyville quadrangle map so that the revised map accurately reflects the territorial boundary line between Shelby Energy and KU. Shelby Energy representatives will work with KU representatives to perform the field work.

Shelby Energy representatives stated they will file a status update on the revisions by December 1, 2014. Once the revisions are finalized, Shelby Energy representatives will submit revised maps signed by Shelby Energy and KU under a cover letter explaining the revisions.

There being no further discussion, the IC was then adjourned.


