To Whom It May Concern:

I am opposed to the Blue Grass Energy request to raise rates to 2.6% for no later than Dec 14, 2015.

I am on a fixed income and do not believe I can pay around \$127.00 a month for an electricity bill from Blue Grass Energy. My current electric bill runs between \$70 to \$90 a month this year, 2014.

I have set up with Blue Grass Energy a 'leveralized account budget' that I run a negative balance until the next billing. And that negative balance grows each & every month after. I pay a total amount of \$50 to \$55 on this budget account.

I do have Energy Saver^{device} on my central air conditioner (which I did not use much this past summer of 2014) and a device on my water heater.

I read The Lexington Herald-Leader notice about Blue Grass Energy proposed rate increase before the Public Service Commission, on Nov. 11, 2014; as well in The Falmouth Outlook on Nov. 12, 2014.

I do not want to see an electricity increase until electricity comes from the proposed natural gas-fired plant, not before.
