# COMMISSION STAFF'S THIRD REQUEST FOR INFORMATION TO NORTHERN KENTUCKY WATER DISTRICT

Northern Kentucky Water District ("Northern District"), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, is to file with the Commission an original and one copy in paper medium and an electronic version of the following information. The information requested herein is due on or before October 12, 2015. Responses to requests for information in paper meduim shall be appropriately bound, tabbed and indexed. Each response shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided.

Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

Northern District shall make timely amendment to any prior response if it obtains information which indicates that the response was incorrect when made or, though correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect. For any request to which

Northern District fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, Northern District shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When filling a document containing personal information, Northern District shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the document so that personal information cannot be read.

- 1. Refer to Northern District's response to Commission Staff's First Request for Information ("Staff's First Request"), Item 8.
- a. Provide the test-year employee salary wage information in the format provided herein in Schedule 1.
- b. Provide the pro forma employee salary wage information in the format provided herein in Schedule 2.
- c. Provide the employee wage information requested above in Items

  1.a. and 1.b. in Microsoft Excel spreadsheet, electronic format with all formulas intact.
- d. Provide the total test-period salaries and wages Northern District capitalized and include the total capitalization percentage. Include all calculations, assumptions and work papers Northern District used to calculate its response.
- e. Provide the date Northern District granted its employees the wage rates listed in the current column.

- f. Verify that the test-year salaries and wages requested do not reflect the wage increases that Northern District granted its employees in 2015.
- g. If the salary and wage information referenced above in Item 1.f. is accurate, explain why Northern District did not propose to adjust its test-year salaries and wages expense—employees to reflect the pay increases that were granted in calendar year 2015.
- 2. Refer to Northern District's response to Staff's First Request, Items 8 and 9.c.
- a. For each employee position identified in the response to Item 8.a. as being terminated in the test year and will not be replaced, provide the following information that was originally requested in Item 9.c.:
  - Reported test-year salary;
  - (2) Test-year salary that was capitalized;
  - (3) Retirement;
  - (4) Payroll taxes reported in 2014; and
  - (5) Insurance benefits paid in 2014.
- b. Provide a detailed explanation for why the costs identified above in the response to Item 2.a. should not be removed from Northern District's test-year operating expenses.
- 3. Refer to Northern District's response to Staff's First Request, Items 8 and 11.

a. In the table below are comparisons of the fringe benefit costs that were provided by Northern District in its responses. Provide a detailed explanation for the differing amounts.

- c. Verify that Northern District is not proposing to include amortization of its rate case cost in the test-year operating expenses.
- d. Provide the updated rate case costs as requested in Staff's First Request, Item 13.a.

- a. Provide a detailed explanation of Northern District's adjustment to eliminate 15 percent of test-year depreciation expense from its revenue requirement calculation.

- c. In its response to Staff's Second Request, Item 4.a., Northern District states, "Debt from the Kentucky Infrastructure Authority (KIA) is subordinate debt, therefore it is not required to be considered in the debt covenant calculation." Provide a copy of the KIA debt agreement or bond ordinance that supports Northern District's position that subordinate debt is not required to be considered in the debt covenant calculation.
