ORDER

On June 16, 2015, the Commission initiated this case upon its own motion to investigate the issues surrounding the Trimble County Generating Station and Ghent Generating Station landfills. Louisville Gas & Electric Company, Kentucky Utilities Company, Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc., and Sterling Ventures, LLC were made parties to the case. On June 19, 2015, an informal conference was held during which all parties participated. In the course of the informal conference the parties discussed the need for a procedural schedule and agreed upon dates for the procedural schedule, subject to the Commission's acceptance of the proposed dates.

The Commission, finding that a procedural schedule will aid in the orderly disposition of this matter, HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. The procedural schedule set forth in the Appendix to this Order shall be followed.

2. a. Responses to requests for information in paper medium shall be appropriately bound, tabbed, and indexed, and shall include the name of the witness

responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided, with the original in paper medium and an electronic copy to the Commission.

b. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

c. Any party shall make timely amendment to any prior response if it obtains information which indicates that the response was incorrect when made or, though correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect.

d. For any request to which a party fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, that party shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

e. A party filing a document containing personal information shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the document so that personal information cannot be read.

3. Any party filing testimony shall file with the Commission an original in paper medium and an electronic copy. The original in paper medium should be appropriately bound, tabbed and indexed.

4. A person who submits a motion to intervene after July 2, 2015, and, upon a showing of good cause, is granted full intervention shall accept and abide by the existing procedural schedule.

5. The Commission does not look favorably upon motions for continuance. Consequently, motions for extensions of time with respect to the schedule herein shall be made in writing and will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

6. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering further Orders in this matter.
