


3. The proposed construction consists of two new 2.0 mile, 161 kV transmission lines in northern Hancock County, Kentucky. The purpose of the proposed transmission lines is to serve a proposed expansion at the Aleris Rolled Products, Inc. (“Aleris”) aluminum mill in Lewisport, Kentucky. The route for the proposed lines begins at the existing Big Rivers Coleman EHV substation, which is located east of the Aleris aluminum mill. From this

substation, the lines will extend west approximately 2.0 miles to two substations at the Aleris aluminum mill. The transmission lines will typically be constructed using single pole steel structures. 807 KAR 5:120 Section 2(b).

4. The proposed transmission lines will be located entirely within Hancock County, Kentucky. 807 KAR 5:120 Section 2(c).
