The Commission Staff has reviewed the application in the above case. This filing is rejected for the reasons set forth below.

Filing deficiencies pursuant to:

- (1) 807 KAR 5:001, Section 14(3) - If applicant is a limited liability corporation, the applicant shall identify in the application the state in which it is organized and the date on which it was organized, attest that it is in good standing in the state in which it is organized, and, if it is not a Kentucky limited liability company, state whether it is authorized to transact business in Kentucky.
- (2) 807 KAR 5:076, Section 4(1)(e) – Most recent state and federal tax returns.
- (3) 807 KAR 5:076, Section 4(1)(h) – Completed ARF Form-3 for each member of board of directors/commissioners, CEO or general manager, ownership of 10% or more.
- (4) 807 KAR 5:076, Section 5(4) – Does notice of proposed rate adjustment meet regulatory requirements?
 - (a) - The date the proposed rates are expected to be filed with the commission;
 - (e) - A statement that a person may examine this application at the offices of (utility name) located at (utility address);
 - (f) - A statement that a person may examine this application at the commission's offices located at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., or through the commission's Web site at <http://psc.ky.gov>;

(g) - A statement that comments regarding the application may be submitted to the Public Service Commission through the commission's Web site or by mail to Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 615, Frankfort, Kentucky 40602;


(i) - A statement that a person may submit a timely written request for intervention to the Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 615, Frankfort, Kentucky 40602, establishing the grounds for the request including the status and interest of the party; and;

(j) - A statement that if the commission does not receive a written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of initial publication or mailing of the notice, the commission may take final action on the application.

The statutory time period in which the Commission must process this case will not commence until the above-mentioned required information is filed with the Commission. You are requested to file this information within 10 days of the date of this letter.
