RE: Informal Conference of April 12, 2016

Pursuant to the Commission's March 31, 2016 Order, an informal conference was held in this matter on April 12, 2016. A copy of the sign-in sheet is attached.

During the conference, Mr. Spenard stated that Commission Staff ("Staff") would prepare minutes of the conference for the case record, that a copy of the minutes would be entered into the record, and that the parties would have an opportunity to submit written comments upon the minutes. Mr. Spenard stated that the views of Staff are not binding on the Commission and that the purpose of the meeting was to discuss the status of and issues in this case.

Mr. Osterloh, Counsel for Water Service Corporation of Kentucky ("WSCK") discussed the major features of the Stipulation, Partial Settlement Agreement and Recommendation ("Partial Settlement"). Rebecca Goodman and Kent Chandler, Counsel for the Office of the Attorney General ("AG"), and Mary Potter, Counsel for the City of Clinton ("Clinton") also discussed the Partial Settlement and the settlement process.

Staff asked the parties to elaborate upon certain aspects of the Partial Settlement and inquired as to whether the parties might be able to reach a "global" or comprehensive settlement. No party indicated an unwillingness to engage in further negotiations. Ms. Potter noted that the next meeting of the Clinton City Council is scheduled for May 2, 2016; therefore, if the parties were able to agree to the terms of a comprehensive settlement, Clinton would not be in a position to approve the settlement prior to the April 19, 2016 hearing.

Staff identified areas of concern with WSCK's proposal that WSCK should be prepared to address at the hearing.

There being no further business, the informal conference adjourned.
