WITH THE BLINKING LIGHT ON. IN THIS PARTICULAR  
ALLOTMENT THE TRUCK WAS SITTING JUST INSIDE THE  
ENTRANCE DRIVE. THIS WAS THE MIDDLE OF THE MONTH  
AND NO ONE HAD MOVED IN OR OUT TO NEED A  
METER READING AND THE READINGS ARE DONE THE FIRST  
OF THE MONTH. THIS IS NOT VERY GOOD COST CONTAIN-  
MENT. VEHICLE EXPENSES ARE ALWAYS COSTLY AND  
IF EVERY TRUCK IS DOING THIS IT'S A VERY LARGE SUM  
OF MONEY INVOLVED.
