MINUTES OF THE INFORMATION SESSION AND PUBLIC MEETING BLUEGRASS COMMUNITY AND TECHNICAL COLLEGE LEESTOWN CAMPUS, CONFERENCE CENTER LEXINGTON, KENTUCKY JUNE 7, 2016, 5:30 P.M.

A public information session and public meeting was held at Bluegrass Community and Technical College, Leestown Campus, in Lexington, Kentucky, on June 7, 2016. Andrew Melnykovych, Director of Communications for the Public Service Commission, conducted the information session introducing the Commission and Commission Staff, and he explained the procedure and protocol for the information session and public hearing. Mr. Melnykovych then presented an overview of the legal basis, criteria and review process for the Commission's consideration of applications for proposed rate increases. The presentation included a general overview of the instant application, explained which aspects of this case are within the Commission's jurisdiction, and concluded with a question-and-answer period.

At the conclusion of the information session and after a short intermission, Vice Chairman Daniel E. Logsdon, Jr., initiated the public hearing portion of the meeting, provided a brief overview of the case at bar and the parties involved, and explained the procedure and protocol for the taking of comments. Vice Chairman Logsdon then

invited the public to make comments to the Commission regarding Kentucky-American Water Company's ("KAWC") application for an adjustment in rates to increase adjusted annual revenue from water rates by approximately \$13.45 million, to establish a Qualified Infrastructure Program ("QIP") surcharge, and for an increase in tap-on fees. The following individuals spoke at the public meeting:

- 1. Lovell C. Foushee III: Mr. Foushee thanked the Commission for Mr. Melnykovych's presentation and also the opportunity to speak. He stated that he had filed written comments and received a reply to those comments from the Kentucky Office of the Attorney General. He stated that he had spoken with representatives of KAWC. Mr. Foushee stated that he had a number of reasons as to why he is against the water rate increase; further, he stated that the city of Lexington should control the water company.
- 2. Marty Soloman: Dr. Soloman stated that he was puzzled concerning the fair and reasonable concept of ratemaking. He stated that he assumed that the rates granted to KAWC in 2008 were copacetic and further that he had reviewed KAWC's annual reports on file at the Commission for the years since 2008. Dr. Soloman stated that every year KAWC reports net income, the amount after all expenses are paid, and that on an annual basis the net profit goes up 85 percent for an 850% increase in profits over ten years. He stated that he has a difficult time understanding how KAWC's rates are reasonable. He stated that he does not understand how KAWC is eligible for a rate increase and that it seems that KAWC is eligible for rate decrease. Dr. Solomon stated that reasonable increases and 85 percent a year profit increases are incompatible. Dr. Solomon indicated that the Commission should look at this issue.

- 3. Warren Rogers: Mr. Rogers thanked the Commission for the opportunity to address the Commission. He stated that he owns a construction company that builds water and wastewater treatments plants in Kentucky and surrounding states. His company's projects include work for municipal utilities and also KAWC. He stated that he is thankful that he lives in a community where the water utility is concerned about the infrastructure and invests regularly in the infrastructure and keeps it up to standards to deliver quality water service to its customers. He stated that he and his family have good, clean, reliable water service in Lexington. He stated that he does not want the PSC to do anything to discourage KAWC from continuing to invest in infrastructure improvements.
- 4. <u>Marilyn Dishman</u>: Ms. Dishman stated that she had spoken with representatives of KAWC who had answered her questions and done a good job of explaining things to her. She wanted this fact to be known on the record and further stated that she does not have any more questions.

No other member of the public wished to make a comment. The public hearing was then adjourned. All persons in attendance were asked to sign in and provide their home address for the record. The sign-in sheet is attached hereto as Appendix A.
