Public Service Commission,

I am writing in regards to LG&E's request to once again increase the Environmental Surcharge on its customers. The environmental surcharge currently stands at 10.570% already and continues to rise each month. This time in 2012, the charge was 0.430%. The surcharge more than doubled to 1.140% by this time in 2013. It more than doubled again to 3.310% in 2014. By this time in 2015 the Environmental Surcharge had increased to 5.800%, and has once again nearly doubled to the 10.570% we pay today. This is essentially a tax on every citizen in the LG&E footprint and I'd encourage you to reject this proposal for further increases. The Kentucky State income tax is 6%, property taxes are around 1%, sales tax is 6%. If

this proposal passes, the Environmental Surcharge will in 2 years surpass the tax rate on cigarettes. I think that it's time that we say enough is enough and ask LG&E to make more *efficient* use the over 10% that they are already taking from our pockets. Thank you for your time and consideration.
