ORDER

This matter arises due to the failure of certain parties to this administrative investigation to file responses to the Commission Staff's First Request for Information issued on April 6, 2016, and Commission Staff's Second Request for Information issued on June 22, 2016 (collectively, "Requests for Information"). By this Order the Commission requires the nonresponsive parties to respond to the Requests for Information or potentially be subject to a show cause proceeding and the penalties enumerated in KRS 278.990.

On February 1, 2016, the Commission initiated this administrative proceeding to investigate the current and future funding, distribution, and administration of the Kentucky Universal Service Fund ("KUSF"). The Commission named as parties, *inter alia*, all Local Exchange Carriers, all commercial mobile radio service providers, and all eligible telecommunications carriers (collectively, "Carriers") and provided that certain parties could petition the Commission to be dismissed as a party from the case. As of the date of this Order, the Commission has dismissed approximately 136 parties from this case.

Pursuant to Commission Order entered February 1, 2016, each Carrier that remained as a party to the case was to comply with the procedural schedule. To date,

the parties listed in Appendix A to this Order have not responded to the Requests for Information issued pursuant to the procedural schedule, nor have they submitted a motion, or any other document, seeking additional time in which to respond or to withdraw as a party.

807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(12)(b), states that:

Commission staff, through the commission's executive director, may request information from any party to a case on the commission's behalf.

KRS 278.990(1) states that:

Any officer, agent, or employee of a utility, as defined in KRS 278.010, and any other person who . . . fails to obey any order of the commission from which all rights of appeal have been exhausted . . . shall be subject to either a civil penalty to be assessed by the commission not to exceed two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) for each offense or a criminal penalty of imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. If any utility willfully violates any of the provisions of this chapter or any regulation promulgated pursuant to this chapter, or does any act therein prohibited, or fails to perform any duty imposed upon it under those sections for which no penalty has been provided by law, or fails to obey any order of the commission from which all rights of appeal have been exhausted, the utility shall be subject to a civil penalty to be assessed by the commission for each offense not less than twenty-five dollars (\$25) nor more than two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500). Each act, omission, or failure by an officer, agent, or other person acting for or employed by a utility and acting within the scope of his employment shall be deemed to be the act, omission, or failure of the utility.

Based on the evidence of record, the Commission finds that:

1. The Requests for Information were issued pursuant to and in compliance with the February 1, 2016 Order.

2. These parties listed in Appendix A to this Order have not filed responses to the Requests for Information, nor have they filed any motion requesting an extension of time to file the responses or any motion to withdraw as a party.

3. The parties listed in Appendix A to this Order must file, within ten days of the date of this Order, responses to the April 4, 2016 and June 22, 2016 Requests for Information, attached to this Order as Appendix B and Appendix C, respectively.

4. Any party listed in Appendix A that fails to file responses to the Requests for Information within the time set forth above may be subject to penalties pursuant to KRS 278.990.

The Commission also notes that Nextlink Wireless, LLC and Defense Mobile Corporation, since the initiation of this action, have ceased providing service in Kentucky and have notified the Commission that they no longer wish to be active utilities. Therefore, it is appropriate to dismiss Nextlink Wireless, LLC and Defense Mobile Corporation as parties to this proceeding.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Within ten days of the date of this Order, the parties listed in Appendix A of this Order shall file with the Commission responses to the Requests for Information attached to this Order as Appendix B and Appendix C.



If responses are not received within ten days of the date of this Order, a show cause proceeding will be initiated to determine whether there are any reasons why penalties should not be imposed upon any nonresponsive party pursuant to KRS 278.990 for its failure to comply with this Order and the Orders entered on April 4, 2016, and June 22, 2016.

3. Nextlink Wireless, LLC and Defense Mobile Corporation are dismissed as parties to this case.

COMMISSION STAFF'S FIRST REQUEST FOR INFORMATION TO
ALL PARTIES OF RECORD

All parties ("Parties") to this proceeding, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, are to file with the Commission an original in paper medium and an electronic version of the following information. The information requested herein is due on or before April 27, 2016. Responses to requests for information in paper medium shall be appropriately bound, tabbed and indexed. Each response shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided.

Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

Parties shall make timely amendment to any prior response if they obtain information which indicates that the response was incorrect when made or, though correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect. For any request to which Parties fail or refuse to furnish all or part of the requested information, they shall provide

a written explanation of the specific grounds for their failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When filing a paper containing personal information, Parties shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that personal information cannot be read.

Requests for Information to Parties that Received Payment from the Kentucky Universal Service Fund ("KUSF")

1. Provide the KUSF reimbursement forms submitted to the Commission and the Department of Finance and Administration from January 2014 to the present.

2. Provide the Federal Communication Commission ("FCC") Form 497 submitted to the FCC from January 2014 to the present.

3. Refer to the Lifeline plans you filed with the Commission with your Application for Designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier ("ETC"). State whether there have been changes to these Lifeline plans since the Commission entered an Order designating you as an ETC for the purpose of offering Lifeline service in Kentucky. If there have been changes to the Lifeline plans, provide:

a. Copies of all Lifeline plans currently offered to Kentucky subscribers.

b. For each new or modified Lifeline plan, explain in detail:

(1) How the current Lifeline plan modifies the Lifeline plan in effect when you were designated as an ETC;

(2) Whether the current Lifeline plan was offered in addition to Lifeline plans in effect when you were designated as an ETC.

c. An explanation for why existing Lifeline plans were changed or additional Lifeline plans were added.

4. If the Commission's decision is to maintain state Lifeline support for only voice service, describe how that decision would affect whether and how you provide Lifeline service in Kentucky.

5. Identify any cost-effective procedures that you believe should be implemented by the Commission to increase oversight of the Lifeline program.

6. If the Commission's decision is to change the amount of Lifeline support, state how soon upon the issuance of an Order by the Commission changing the Lifeline support amount that you are or anticipate being able to implement the changes on customer bills.

7. Provide, in detail, the methods employed to verify the eligibility of customers who participate in the Lifeline program.

8. State whether you have been subjected to FCC investigation, action, and/or penalties relating to participation in the Lifeline program. If you have been so subjected, provide in detail, including citations to the FCC action, the investigation, action, and/or penalties to which you were subjected.

9. Describe, in detail, your current marketing programs for Lifeline service in Kentucky, including, but not limited to, person-to-person sales.

Requests for Information to All Parties

1. Provide the KUSF reimbursement forms submitted to the Commission and the Department of Finance and Administration from January 2014 to the present.

2. Explain how the total number of subscriber lines is calculated for the KUSF reimbursement form when a new customer receives service in the middle of a month.

3. Explain how the total number of subscriber lines is calculated for the KUSF reimbursement form when a customer leaves in the middle of a month.

4. Explain how the KUSF surcharge remittance is calculated when you experience a bad debt. Explain whether none of the surcharge amount or the full surcharge amount billed to, but not paid by, the customer is remitted.

5. State whether you believe the Commission should wait until the FCC's investigation of Lifeline Reform¹ is concluded before rendering a decision in this proceeding, and explain the basis for your response.

6. State how soon upon the issuance of an Order by the Commission changing the KUSF surcharge that you are or anticipate being able to implement the changes on customer bills. If it differs by type of account, provide the information for each type of account, along with the number of access lines for each account type.


