ORDER

On September 23, 2016, the Kentucky Manufactured Housing Institute ("KMHI") filed an application for a declaratory order regarding the Commission's jurisdiction over mobile home communities that utilize sub-metering for water service provided to tenants within mobile home communities. The Commission's regulation governing applications for declaratory orders, 807 KAR 5:001, Section 19(3), provides that the Commission may direct that a copy of the application be served on a person who may be affected by the application. Further, Section 19(4) of that regulation provides that responses to the application may be filed within 21 days of filing the application; and section 19(8) provides that the Commission may extend the time for filing any response to the application.

Having considered the application and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that the jurisdictional issue raised in the KMHI application may affect water utilities regulated by the Commission. For this reason, we will serve a copy of the KMHI application and this Order on the Kentucky Rural Water Association ("KRWA"), whose members include all water utilities regulated by the Commission except for two investor-owned water utilities, and to each of the two investor-owned water utilities not

members of KRWA, Kentucky American Water Company and Water Service Corporation of Kentucky. In addition, the application and this Order will also be served on the Attorney General's Office of Rate Intervention ("AG"). Further, we find that the time for filing any response should be extended to 21 days from the date of this Order. Finally, a person filing a response need not file a motion to intervene, but absent intervention being requested and granted by the Commission, the person filing a response will not be considered a party to this case.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- A copy of the KMHI application and this Order shall be electronically served on the KRWA, Kentucky American Water Company, Water Service Corporation of Kentucky, and the AG.
- Any person filing a response to the KMHI application shall upload within
 days of the date of this Order an electronic version using the Commission's E-Filing
 System and shall file an original and six copies in paper medium.
- 3. KMHI shall have 42 days from the date of this Order to electronically file a reply by uploading an electronic version using the Commission's E-Filing System and filing an original and six copies in paper medium.
- 4. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering further Orders in the matter.
- 5. Materials submitted to the Commission which do not comply with the rules of procedure or that do not have an approved deviation from these rules are subject to rejection pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 3.
