## ORDER

On December 29, 2009, in Case No. 2009-00202,<sup>1</sup> the Commission approved rates for Duke Energy Kentucky, Inc. ("Duke") and provided for their further adjustment in accordance with Duke's Gas Cost Adjustment ("GCA") clause.

On October 6, 2016, Duke filed its GCA to be effective October 28, 2016.

After reviewing the record in this case and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

- 1. Duke's notice includes rates designed to pass on to its customers its expected change in wholesale gas costs.
- 2. Duke's Expected Gas Cost ("EGC") is \$3.960 per Mcf, which is a decrease of \$.259 per Mcf from its previous EGC of \$4.219 per Mcf.
  - 3. Duke's notice sets out no Refund Adjustment.
- 4. Duke's notice sets out its current quarter Actual Adjustment ("AA") of (\$.055) per Mcf. Duke's total AA is \$.388 per Mcf, which is no change from its previous total AA.

- 4. Duke's notice sets out its current quarter Actual Adjustment ("AA") of (\$.055) per Mcf. Duke's total AA is \$.388 per Mcf, which is no change from its previous total AA.
- 5. Duke's notice sets out its current quarter Balance Adjustment ("BA") of (\$.006) per Mcf. Duke's total BA is \$.078 per Mcf, which is no change from its previous total BA.
- 6. Duke's GCA is \$4.426 per Mcf, which is a decrease of \$.259 per Mcf from its previous GCA of \$4.685 per Mcf.
- 7. The rates as proposed by Duke and set forth in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved for final meter readings by Duke on and after October 28, 2016.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The rates proposed by Duke and set forth in the Appendix to this Order are approved for final meter readings on and after October 28, 2016.
- 2. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Duke shall file with this Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, revised tariff sheets setting out the rates approved herein and reflecting that they were approved pursuant to this Order.
