MINUTES OF THE INFORMATION SESSION AND PUBLIC MEETING VALLEY HIGH SCHOOL LOUISVILLE, KENTUCKY MAY 23, 2016 5:30 P.M.

A public information session and public meeting was held at Valley High School in Louisville, Jefferson County, Kentucky, on May 23, 2016. Andrew Melnykovych, Director of Communications for the Public Service Commission, conducted the information session introducing the Commission and Commission Staff, and explained the procedure and protocol for the information session and the public hearing. Mr. Melnykovych then presented an overview of the legal basis, criteria and review process for the Commission's consideration of applications for proposed rate increase. The presentation included a general overview of the instant application, explained which aspects of this case are within the Commission's jurisdiction, and concluded with a question-and-answer period with Commission Staff.

At the conclusion of the information session and after a short intermission, Vice Chairman Daniel E. Logsdon, Jr., accompanied by Commissioner Robert Cicero,

initiated the public hearing portion of the meeting, providing a brief overview of the case at bar, the parties involved, and setting forth the procedure and protocol for the taking of comments. Vice Chairman Logsdon then invited the public to make comments to the Commission regarding Louisville Gas and Electric Company's ("LG&E") environmental compliance plans and associated environmental surcharge which is estimated to increase the total electric bills for LG&E customers by 2.5 percent by 2020 and then decline through 2024.

No members of the public wished to make a comment. The public hearing was then adjourned. All persons in attendance were asked to sign in and provide their home address for the record. The sign-in sheet is attached hereto as Appendix A.
