Dear Public Service Commission,

I am writing you today to request that you reject KU's proposed rate increases (Case No 2016-00370). The jump in flat-cost service fees is bad for both for families and our environment. By seeking increased revenue through service fees as opposed to usage fees KU is removing the cost incentives for consumers to reduce their energy use. Working families who are looking to reduce their monthly expenses by cutting back on their energy use will not see a fair drop on their utility bills for their efforts if cost increases are fixed.

This also presents a missed opportunity for Kentucky's environment as households see no motivation for reducing the amount of energy provided from coal burning power plants that harm our air and water.

For these reasons I am asking that you reject KU's proposed rate increases.

In response to your Case No. 2016-00370 I will respond by letter and email to ensure that KU a ppl company receives my input on this rate hike that is planned with less than 40 days' notice. As your letter states this application was applied for on November 23, 2016.

I received this information on December the 23rd. 2016

As I now have three accounts with KU "soon to be four" I have questions about this rate hike that KU has asked for on this short notice.

1. Who asked for this increase of approximately 6.4% In general, was it the stockholders, the board of directors? Who.

Note: 1. Over the past three years the Cola has not been granted to most of us on a fixed income, and if it was it was set at 0.3%. This means I get a \$2.97 per month Increase as do most that live on a fixed income. Now compound that amount to the vast number of KU customers on a fixed income.

2. Looking at the rate chart that you have submitted to me on the above date, it has caused much confusion to myself as to what my rate increases will be, (the bottom line is it is very hard to understand). I can only guess that I will pay from \$5.91-to \$7.16 over what I pay now as I look at this chart!
3. I cannot afford that much of an increase to my already high usage of Power in my household and am forwarding this information on to Mitch McConnell, Rand Paul as well as my state Legislator's as well

Thank you in advance and please respond to my questions in a timely manner and know that I have never had a complaint with KU in the years that we have been with them.
