It restricts the growth of clean energy industries—like solar and energy efficiency—just when Kentucky needs the jobs from those promising industries the most. It will also limit our freedom to choose our energy source by penalizing the use of renewable energy. This is an unjust, unfair, and unreasonable proposal that is contrary to Kentucky law. We, the undersigned, call on the Public Service Commission to deny this rate change!
