Aep is selling this electricity on the the PJM inter connect grid to people in 13 states including New York. I am sure AEP gets more for electricity on the PJM grid since AEP has a 15 year plan for their companies, why did AEP not plan to convert the Big Sand power plant to Natural gas and sell this electricity to Ky power customers. By doing this: Ky power customers would not be paying for 2 power plants. Pres. Trump recinded all of Obama's rules governing power plants.
