I hear on the news that KY Power company is asking for a rate increase in southeastern KY. I would like to inform you that here in the Neon area and probably all over Letcher County, KY Power has already doubled most of our electric bills that we have received for Nov. Some have increased even more. I am a widow living in a small mobile home and 3 days a week, I do volunteer work with my church and am not at home during the day. I rarely cook a meal usually eating frozen dinners or eating left overs from when I cook maybe 1 time a week. My use of electricity did not increase

enough to cause my electric bill increase from \$77 to \$166 dollars in one month. All my friends and neighbors saw increase from \$100 to their electric bills being doubled or sometimes even more.

I lived in Central KY for the past 28 years and had KU formy electricity and the electric bill for a 3 bedoom home never had that type of increase...the people in Letcher County cannot handle this type of increase and now KY Power is requesting even more. As you know, the employment rate in the county is poor and most people live on fixed incomes. Many of us will not be able to pay these ridiculous increase and still have money for food, medicines, and other essential needs. Please, I am requesting you interview people here and kniw that I am telling the truth. There was no earthly reason for the electric bills to have this much of a hike in one month and now they are asking for more. We need your help.
