
The meeting was called to order by Randall Hardin. Millow D. made a motion to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Kenneth seconded the motion. All voted Yea.

Millow D. made a motion to approve payment of all bills. Kenneth seconded the motion. All voted Yea.

Allen reported on the tank bids that were opened on June 14th. He proposed that the board accept the low bid from Huffman Tank. He updated the board on the Lacy pump station. He also updated the board on the line relocation project.

Allen informed the board that the Magoffin County Water District received notification from Salyersville Water Works that rates will be increased by three percent (3%) to all of their customers including the Magoffin County Water District, therefore Allen recommended to the board to pass the increase on to our customers. Teresa made a motion to pass along the increase to Magoffin County Water District customers with the stipulation that all city customers receive a three percent (3%) increase also. Kenneth seconded the motion. All voted Yea.
