When does it cost double to treat treated household water. this is a small system handling 20 houses of which 6 are weekend or summer seldom used homes. that leaves 14 normal households. the normal water bill of the neighborhood is \$25.00. so this commission is acknowledging this sewer treatment plant per his accounting [?], requires double the cost to treat TREATED household water. this cost increase seems blatantly inflated to this resident. other than normal chemical water treatment I know of NO repairs, improvements, additional hook ons, or other considerations to warrant such an increase. I cannot believe the cost of purification chemicals has increased to such a level to warrant such a large increase. this granted increase warrants a more intensive review of the operating costs he is apparently claiming.
