Further: (a) while consumers are encouraged to conserve energy (thereby lowering their utility bills), these fixed fees by utility companies are billed at 100% regardless of how much the consumer works at conserving their energy use (i.e. lower energy consumption does not lower the fixed fees); and (b) these fixed fees represent Duke Energy profits.
