

Notice Of Intent

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:120, Section 1, KRS 278.020, and all other applicable statutory provisions and regulations, Kentucky Power Company gives notice of its intent to file on or before November 30, 2017 an application seeking a certificate of public convenience and necessity with respect to its proposed construction project involving the rebuild of the existing Hazard-Wooton transmission line (“Hazard-Wooton Project”) located in Perry and Leslie Counties. The Hazard-Wooton Project involves the rebuild within or near existing Kentucky Power rights-of-way of approximately 5.3 miles of the existing 161 kV electric transmission line.

Kentucky Power also will be constructing approximately 6,230 feet of 161 kV line outside of the existing Hazard-Wooton right-of-way as part of the project. These minor deviations from the existing right-of-way are in the vicinity of Hazard High School in Perry County (City of Hazard) and northeast of the Wooton substation in Leslie County. In addition, the Hazard-Wooton Project will involve associated improvements at the Wooton substation and upgrade, replacement, and installation work at the Hazard substation.


Attached is a map showing the general route of the proposed 161 kV transmission line.
