RE: Informal Conference of January 24, 2018

Pursuant to an Order issued on January 22, 2018, an informal conference ("IC") was conducted on January 24, 2018. Attached is a copy of the attendance roster.

The purpose of the IC was to discuss the respective Applications for certificates of public convenience and necessity ("CPCN") for an advanced metering infrastructure system ("AMI") that were filed by Southeast Daviess County Water District in Case No. 2017-00458, and by West Daviess County Water District (jointly "the Districts") in Case No. 2017-00459. The Districts are separate legal entities that operate under common management.

Commission Staff and representatives of the Districts discussed quantifying the expected cost savings from the AMI system referenced in the respective Applications. For example, without the AMI system, the Districts would have to hire two new staff members, a meter reader and a transmission and distribution ("T&D") employee, in addition to the current two meter readers, in response to the growing customer base. With the AMI system, the Districts will have only one T&D employee, and no meter readers. The Districts will file documents that quantify the expected cost savings and expand upon the intangible benefits of the AMI system on or before February 2, 2018.

There being no further discussion, the IC was then adjourned.
