## NOTICE

Kentucky-American Water Company ("Kentucky American Water") expects to file on November 28, 2018 an application with the Kentucky Public Service Commission to increase the water service revenues by approximately 22.6%. The proposed annual revenue increases by customer classification are: Residential - \$10,908,442 (22.9%); Commercial - \$5,404,101 (25.0%); Industrial - \$579,966 (23.1%); Other Public Authority - \$1,420,526 (24.9%); Sales for Resale - \$367,222 (21.5%); Private Fire Service and Hydrants -\$346,415 (13.0%); Public Fire Hydrants - \$838,067 (23.2%). The proposed effective date of the rates is for service rendered on and after December 28, 2018. Kentucky American Water has requested the proposed rates be implemented to all customer classifications as shown below:

Kentucky American Water has also proposed additions to its tariff to include a Qualified Infrastructure Program surcharge that would be applied to Residential, Commercial, Industrial, Other Public Authority, Sale for Resale, Public and Private Fire Service classifications for qualified infrastructure investments. This surcharge would be calculated annually based on forecasted qualified infrastructure costs, and applied to each customer's monthly bill. The surcharge would then be updated annually until the next rate case, at which time the investment costs would be incorporated into base rates and the surcharge reset at zero.

Any person may submit a timely written request for intervention to the Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 615, Frankfort, Kentucky 40602, which establishes the grounds for the request including the status and interest of the party.

If the Public Service Commission does not receive a written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of the providing of this notice, the Public Service Commission may take final action on the application.
