## ORDER

On August 6, 2018, the Commission issued an Order granting Monroe County Water District's (Monroe District) application to modify the Commission's March 18, 2016 Order in Case No. 2015-00315. On August 29, 2018, Monroe District filed with the Commission a petition for rehearing (Petition) in which it requested that the Commission amend its August 6, 2018 Order to permit Monroe District to construct a one-million-gallon flocculation and sedimentation basin and its newly constructed water treatment facility.

On May 22, 2018, Monroe District filed an application with the Commission to modify the Commission's March 18, 2016 Order in Case No. 2015-00315, in which the Commission had approved, *inter alia*, Monroe District's application to construct a new water treatment facility. In the application to modify the March 18, 2016 Order, Monroe District requested additional approval to increase its existing Kentucky Infrastructure ("KIA") to \$15,765,378, an increase of \$111,347, and approval to use the additional funds to construct a flocculation and sedimentation basin. On August 6, 2018, the Commission issued an order in which it approved the additional financing, but did not rule on Monroe District's request for approval to construct the flocculation and sedimentation basin.

Monroe District now requests that the Commission amend its Order so to also approve the construction of the flocculation and sedimentation basin.

The Commission has reviewed the Petition and finds that it should be granted.

The Commission has already approved the funding for the project; it should approve the construction of the project as well.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. Monroe District's Petition for Rehearing is granted.
- 2. The Commission's Order of August 6, 2018, is amended to include the following finding:
  - 7. Monroe District proposes to construct a one-million-gallon sedimentation and flocculation basin at an estimated cost of \$691,551 to meet additional design and construction requirements imposed by the Kentucky Division of Water after its initial approval of proposed water treatment plant.
  - 8. The public convenience and necessity requires the construction of the proposed sedimentation and flocculation basin.
- 3. The Commission's August 6, 2018 Order is amended to include the following ordering paragraph:
  - 10. Monroe District is granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct the proposed sedimentation and flocculation basin.
- 4. All other provisions of the Commission's August 6, 2018 Order not addressed in this Order shall remain in full force and effect.
