ORDER

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:056, the Commission established this case on August 10, 2018, to review and evaluate the operation of the Fuel Adjustment Clause (FAC) of Duke Energy Kentucky, Inc. (Duke Kentucky) for the six-month period that ended on April 30, 2018. As part of this review the Commission held a formal hearing in this matter on October 9, 2018. On October 16, 2018, Duke Kentucky filed its response to Commission Staff's post-hearing data request.

A review of Duke Kentucky's monthly FAC filings shows that the fuel cost billed for the six-month period under review ranged from a low of \$.024023 per kWh in December 2017, to a high of \$.034870 per kWh in March 2018, with a six-month average of \$.028552 per kWh.

The Commission, having considered the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds no evidence of improper calculation or application of Duke Kentucky's FAC charges or improper fuel procurement practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The charges and credits billed by Duke Kentucky through its FAC for the period November 1, 2017, through April 30, 2018, are approved.
2. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
