Boss buzzing you after hours? NYC might let you say buzz of

NEW YORK - Technology that once promised free

NEW YORK — Technology that once promised free-dom from the conf nes of an of ce has, for many work-ers, become a ball and chain, blurring the lines be-tween work hours and, well, any other hours. A New York City Council member wants to put a stop to that. The proposal would bar employers from requiring employees to respond to non-emergency emails, texts and other digital communications outside regular work hours. It would also outlaw retaliating against workers who choose to unplug.

The recently introduced legislation is only in the beginning stages, with initial committee hearings expected sometime in June, and doubters wonder how it could work, especially in always-buzzing New York City.

But bill sponsor Rafael Espinal, a Democrat who represents parts of Brooklyn, said the legislation is

represents parts of Brooklyn, said the legislation is needed because the city that never sleeps isn't sup-posed to be the city that never stops working. "Work has spilled into our personal lives," he said.

"We're always connected to our phones or to a comput-er once we leave the of ce."

er once we leave the or ce.
It's important, he said, for people to be "able to draw
a clear line between the workplace and their personal
lives, to give them time to connect with their family,
friends, reduce their stress levels, and be able to go

Inches, reduce their stress levels, and be able to go back to work and perform at their optimal level."

The legislation would cover private companies with more than 10 employees. There would be exemptions for certain types of jobs that require people to be on call. Barring emergencies, bosses wouldn't be able to demand that workers check work emails or messages is of bours.

Companies that violated the rule would face f nes of at least \$250 per incident.

at reast \$250 per incident.

Espinal said he was inspired by a French law that took ef ect this year that gave employees the right to ignore of -hour communications.

Employers who wanted to return a communication could do so.

"If you love your job, and you love what you're do-ing, I highly doubt that you will stop working," Espinal

The bill would be intended to make life better for The bill would be intended to make life better for people like Arlene Pitterson, a marketing and event planning consultant in Brooklyn, who recalled one boss routinely pestering her with late-night emails and then getting upset when she didn't reply. It was among the conditions that led her to working for herself, and she now sets her own boundaries about when she'll respond to people.

"The fact that we have to get to a point where we



have a law about it is unfortunate, but it's necessary."

said Pitterson, 40.

Technology has allowed us to work from anywhere at any time," she said. "It's now about being able to control the instruments so that we can still have a life." The reality, though, is that the world has become a 24/7 place, and adhering to a policy like the one Espinal is proposing would be detrimental to a company's competitiveness, said labor lawyer Louis DiLorenzo of Bond, Schoeneck & King, who has spent years representing management and employers.

"The problems are going to be tremendous," DiLorenzo said. "I just don't think you can legislate against progress."

Teed envisioned that his New Jerusalem would grow to a population of 10 million. It fell somewhat short of that, peaking at about 250 people in the very early 1900s.
But you have to hand it to the Koreshans: They overcame what would seem to be natural disadvantages.

This turned out to be appealing to a certain segment of late-19th century America: Civil War widows and their chil-dren, who comprised approximately three-fourths of the population of the Koreshan Unity in to the Koreshans: They overcame what would seem to be natural disadvantages. vided a safety net for some families of dead

The Koreshans found The Koreshans found themselves in a political dispute with fellow Lee Countians that turned vi-olent one day in 1906 and Teed suffered a beating from which he never from which he never quite recovered. He died two unhappy years later. Among other things, Teed believed in reincar-nation, and his followers

kept his corpse around for a few days, awaiting news. When none emerged, and a persnick-ety public health physi-cian from Fort Myers de-manded burial of the decaying body, Teed's re-mains were taken out to Estero Island for entomb-

Two years after that, his tomb was washed out to sea by a hurricane, and Teed was not seen again, resurrected or otherwise.

But hand it to the Ko reshans. They were in-

reshans. They were in-dustrious.

They established and staf ed a bakery that baked enough bread to serve their own needs and sell to others.

They operated a con-crete works, boat works, sawmill and an electric generation plant. The Ko-

chine shops and a print-ing plant that produced a newspaper, The Flaming

They created sunken gardens rdens and raised ounds, and raised exot-

mounds, and raised exotic plants.
Their general store was for years the only one between Fort Myers and Naples on what became the Tamieni Tauli the Tamiami Trail.

And not only did any aging society of believers manage to survive for manage to survive decades in the hurrica swept subtropical pal-metto scrub of Southwest Florida, but their commu-nity was one that of ered education and culture both for themselves and

their neighbors.

Remarkable for its time, the settlement for years was a matriarchal

society, managed for years by a group known as The Seven Sisters who lived in separate bed-rooms in a building called

The Planetary Court.
The f nal leader of the The f nal leader of the society — Hedwig Michel, a Jewish woman who f ed Nazi Germany — oversaw the transfer of 305 acres to the state of Florida, which now operates the site as the Koreshan State Park, providing guided. Park, providing guided tours of what is left of the

tours of what is left of the Koreshan Unity. Whether it exists on the exterior of Earth — or on the interior shell — re-mains a matter of inter-pretation.
