SANCTUARY CHURCH'S MOTION FOR USE OF ELECTRONIC FILING PROCEDURES

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Sanctuary Church moves the Public Service Commission (the "Commission") to require the use of electronic filing procedures in this proceeding. In support of its Motion, Sanctuary Church states as follows:

- The Commission's Rules of Procedure, 807 KAR 5:001, permit the use of electronic filing in Section 8. An applicant may elect to use electronic filing, or the Commission may require filing by Order.¹
- 2. Section 8 requires an applicant to submit its notice 7 days prior to its application, however the rule does not prohibit a complainant from moving the Commission to require electronic filing.
- 3. Counsel for Sanctuary Church have registered with the Public Service Commission website to enable electronic filing capability.

4. Sanctuary Church's counsel and authorized representative's electronic mail information is

set forth below.

5. Sanctuary Church's counsel and authorized representatives have read and understand the

policies and procedures for electronic filing set forth in 807 KAR 5:007, Section 8.

6. The Commission has previously granted motions for use of electronic filing when a party,

who is not an applicant, moves the court after the commencement of a case to require

electronic filing.² In the Muhlenberg County Water District case, the Commission held that

electronic filing should be permitted as the case was in the early stages, no parties had

sought intervention, and there were no objections from other parties.

7. This case is in the early stages, only just past the date for initial requests for information

which all parties submitted on August 27, 2018. There is currently no evidence that other

parties seek to intervene. Additionally, Sanctuary Church has obtained agreement from

counsel for LG&E to use electronic filing procedures. Electronic filing procedures will

reduce filing costs for all parties and encourage efficiency.

WHEREFORE, Sanctuary Church moves that the Commission enter an order to designate

this proceeding as an electronic filing proceeding under 807 KAR 5:001.
