Commissioners,

The purpose of this letter is to protest the RATE INCREASE for which B & H Gas Company is asking. I see no reason, whatsoever, to give B & H gas an almost 78% increase.

About a month ago, our gas was off. The gas was turned back on to our house without any safety notification. In the winter time, when the weather is below freezing for any length of time, B & H gas has difficulty maintaining pressure on their lines.

It's hard to understand how Mr. Rife can charge \$5.8083^{per} gas he is buying from himself. He can purchase gas from Columbia Gas, Diversified Oil and Gas, Core, or Independent producers in this area cheaper.

As of today, Dec. 31, 2018, on the Henry Hub natural gas was selling for \$2.99 as of 3:18 PM. The Bank's weather outlook calls for natural gas prices to average \$2.99 per mmbtu this winter.

My husband and I are retired. We do not have a lot of extra money to spend on heating bills.

Please consider NOT approving the outrageous request for a rate increase.
