I am writing in protest to the resent notice from the Johnson County Gas Company for an increase in customer cost. From what I understand natural gas prices are at the lowest in recent years. My question to the Kentucky Public Service Commission is why they would need a raise when buying gas at such low prices.

The Johnson County Gas Company has been long plagued with mismanagement and poor fiscal responsibility. They have expected their customers to consistently bail them out. Even in the letter signed by Brad Rife, their request is very ambiguous. It states that the average customer of Johnson County Gas has a monthly usage of 4 mcfs per month then the very next sentence says that in 2017 "customers of Johnson County Gas Company used an average of 1240 mcfs per month. So which one is it 4 or 1240?

I'm a consumer and I feel that if I don't speak up now, Mr. Rife and his staff will see this as an opportunity to continue to raise prices without changing the business plan and fiscal responsibility to their customers.
