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ORDER

On December 20, 2019, Kentucky Power Company (Kentucky Power) filed with the Commission their 2019 Integrated Resource Plan (IRP). The Commission finds that a procedural schedule should be established for the timely processing of this proceeding. The Commission further finds that a hearing should be scheduled for the purpose of taking evidence on the issues within the scope of this investigation of Kentucky Power Company's (Kentucky Power) 2019 Integrated Resource Plan.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

 The procedural schedule set forth in the Appendix to this Order shall be followed in this proceeding.

2. a. Responses to requests for information in paper medium shall be appropriately bound, tabbed, and indexed. Electronic documents shall be in portable document format (PDF), shall be searchable and shall be appropriately bookmarked. Each response shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to questions related to the information provided, with an original in paper medium and an electronic version to the Commission.

b. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or an association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

c. A party shall make timely amendment to any prior response if it obtains information that indicates that the response was incorrect when made or, though correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect.

d. For any request to which a party fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information that party shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

e. Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request.

f. Any party filing a paper containing personal information shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that the personal information cannot be read.

3. Any party filing testimony shall in accordance with the electronic filing procedures set forth in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8, and shall file with the Commission an original and an electronic version. The original should be appropriately bound, tabbed, and indexed.

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4. Any motion to intervene filed after the date in the procedural schedule attached to this Order shall show a basis for intervention and good cause for being untimely. If the untimely motion is granted, the movant shall accept and abide by the existing procedural schedule.

5. Motions for extensions of time with respect to the schedule herein shall be made in writing and will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

6. A hearing in this matter shall be held on Tuesday, October 6, 2020, at 9 a.m. Eastern Daylight Time, in the Richard Raff Hearing Room (Hearing Room 1) at the offices of the Public Service Commission at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky.

7. Kentucky Power shall give notice of the hearing in compliance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(2)(b). In addition, the notice of hearing shall include the following statement: "This hearing will be streamed live and may be viewed on the PSC website, psc.ky.gov." At the time the notice is mailed or publication is requested, Kentucky Power shall forward a duplicate of the notice and request to the Commission.

8. Pursuant to KRS 278.360 and 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(9), a digital video transcript shall be made of the hearing.

9. On or before September 10, 2020, Commission Staff shall schedule an informal conference with the parties for the purpose of discussing the scope of the hearing and identifying witnesses who will offer testimony at the October 6, 2020 hearing.
