### <u>order</u>

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:056, the Commission, on February 11, 2019, established this case to review and evaluate the application of the Fuel Adjustment Clause (FAC) of: Big Sandy Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation, Blue Grass Energy Cooperative Corporation, Clark Energy Cooperative, Inc., Cumberland Valley Electric, Inc., Farmers Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation, Fleming-Mason Energy Cooperative, Inc., Grayson Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation, Inter-County Energy Cooperative Corporation, Jackson Energy Cooperative Corporation, Licking Valley Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation, Nolin Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation, Owen Electric Cooperative, Inc., Salt River Electric Cooperative Corporation, Shelby Energy Cooperative, Inc., South Kentucky Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation, and Taylor County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation (collectively Cooperatives or individually Cooperative) for the two-year period from November 1, 2016, through October 31, 2018. As part of this review, the Commission ordered each Cooperative to individually submit certain information and an affidavit attesting to its adherence to 807 KAR 5:056. The Commission further ordered that a public hearing be held in this case but canceled it when, after publication of notice, no interested person advised the Commission of intent to attend. There are no intervenors in this proceeding.

During the period under review, the Cooperatives have complied in all material respects with the provisions of 807 KAR 5:056. As East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. (EKPC), the wholesale supplier of the Cooperatives, has been ordered to reduce its base energy rates by \$0.00152 per kWh for fuel costs, the Commission finds that each individual Cooperative should reduce its base energy rates as adjusted for line loss, the reduction by EKPC in Case No. 2019-00003<sup>1</sup>.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The charges and credits applied by each individual Cooperative through the FAC for the period from November 1, 2016 Through October 31, 2018, are approved.

2. Each individual Cooperative shall deduct from its base energy rates, adjusted for line loss, to reflect the reduction of \$0.00152 per kWh by EKPC in Case No. 2019-00003.

3. The rates for Big Sandy Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation in Appendix A to this Order are approved for service rendered on and after February 1, 2019, the effective date of EKPC's change in rates. The rates in the Appendix A to this Order are designed to reflect the reduction of \$.00161 per kWh to base energy rates.

4. The rates for Blue Grass Energy Cooperative Corporation in Appendix B to this Order are approved for service rendered on and after February 1, 2019, the effective
