#### <u>ORDER</u>

The Commission, on its own motion, opens this proceeding in order to revise the training requirements for the commissioners of water districts organized pursuant to KRS 74.010, *et. seq.* The Commission last year reviewed the training requirements for commissioners of water districts to ensure that newly appointed commissioners receive adequate and consistent training and have adequate knowledge and experience to fulfill their duties as commissioners. Following that review, the Commission, among other things, determined that water district commissions may only fulfill their 12 hours of initial training required by KRS 74.020(8) by completing each and every core course the Commission offers at its training seminars.<sup>1</sup>

In monitoring last year's training for water district commissioners, the Commission solicited and received input from instructors and participants that included evaluation forms submitted by participants at the conclusion of each training session. Based upon the input received, the Commission finds that the curriculum of its training seminars for new water district commissioners should be revised to focus more on the issues that new water district commissioners are likely to encounter in their first year of service. Commission further finds that the other requirements earlier set forth with regards to both initial and third-party training require no further modification and shall remain in place until modified by future action of the Commission.

Broadly stated, the changes being made to the required training for newly appointed water district commissioners will place greater emphasis on administrative requirements, financial accountability, and the relationship of districts to the Commission. Two courses will be added to the core curriculum, one will be moved to the elective curriculum for water district commissioners fulfilling their annual training, and a number of courses will be modified, as delineated in the Appendix attached to this order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. To satisfy training obligations set forth in KRS 74.020(8), every newly appointed water district commissioner must complete, within the first 12 months following the water district commissioner's appointment, each core course described in the Appendix attached hereto, each of which will be offered at every Commission seminar.

2. All other requirements adopted by the Commission in its final order in Case 2018-00085 shall remain in place and are incorporated by reference in this Order.

3. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
